

**Brooke L. Whisenhunt, Ph.D.**

Brooke Whisenhunt is a Professor of psychology at Missouri State University where she has been a faculty member for the past 16 years. She obtained her Ph.D. in clinical psychology from Louisiana State University in 2002. From 2011 until 2013, she was a member of the introductory psychology redesign team at Missouri State University as part of a statewide mission in course redesign through the National Center for Academic Transformation (NCAT). During that timeframe, the redesign team transformed introductory psychology at Missouri State University into a blended course and demonstrated significant improvements in learning outcomes. The results of this project have published in *Psychology Learning and Teaching* and *Scholarship of Teaching and Learning in Psychology*. Since the completion of the redesign project, Dr. Whisenhunt has been serving as a Missouri Learning Commons Scholar to assist other institutions in the state implement redesign projects. She is also a National Center for Academic Transformation (NCAT) Redesign Scholar. She has presented across the country about pedagogical strategies to improve learning, decrease institutional costs, and improve retention in introductory psychology. She is the co-author of a new, interactive text for Introductory Psychology, *Revel Psychology* 1<sup>st</sup> edition.
